(Hereafter “**Seneca**” or “**Seneca Polytechnic**”)

(Each a “**Party**”, collectively the “**Parties**”)

This Memorandum of Understanding (“MOU” or “Memorandum”) confirms the cooperation between **TEC** and **Seneca**. The cooperation seeks to widen the educational and career opportunities of students and create possibilities for academic and professional exchange of students and faculty.

**1. Objectives**

- (a) Collaborative applied research projects in areas of mutual interest;
- (b) Joint programs, articulations, and projects where appropriate;
- (c) Participation in workshops, seminars, summer schools, and other short-term programs;
- (d) Mobility of students, faculty and other employees;
- (e) Other collaborations of mutual interest.

**2. General Terms**

- (a) The Parties may enter into specific written agreements under authority of this MOU to clarify and define the nature, extent and terms of operation for the

proposed collaborations, including intellectual property and financial arrangements.

(b) The activities of this MOU must be carried out in accordance with appropriate laws and regulations existing in each country and institution.

**3. Liaison and Administration**

Each Party shall appoint a coordinator for this partnership and keep the other party informed of the name and address of that person.

**4. Duration of Memorandum**

This Memorandum shall be effective for three years from the date signed and is to be automatically renewed for a further three years period unless either Party gives notice of termination not later than six months prior to the expiry of any term of the Memorandum. The terms of this Memorandum may be amended at any time subject to mutual written agreement by both Parties.

This Memorandum is written in English.

**5. Additional Information**

The operational details of any project under this Memorandum may be governed by terms and conditions to be separately negotiated and mutually agreed upon by both Parties through an exchange of letters or the signing of a subsidiary joint agreement.
